



## Crimes Update

Hello to you from West Midlands Police and the Pendeford and Oxley team, over the last week there has been a few crimes of note.

Firstly, on the 18th April there was a burglary residential in Blanefield. Where offenders have gained access to the property via an insecure window. Once inside offenders have got the keys to the vehicle and made off in the vehicle. Unfortunately, the vehicle was later involved in an RTC on Wheatsheaf Road with a lamppost and wall.

On the 19th April in the early evening, unknown offenders have gained access to Oxley Park Golf Club, and once inside the premises have got onto the golf buggies and drove them around causing criminal damage to the buggies.

Sadly, another burglary to mention on the 20th April in Burnham Avenue, where again offenders have gained entry via a window which was just left ajar. A few various electrical items were taken and keys to their vehicle. Thankfully the vehicle wasn't taken.

On the 22nd April in Penshaw Close there was a burglary. Offenders have entered property via insecure window/door, and once inside offenders have taken a handbag with money and bank cards in.

It seems to be a pattern at the minute with offenders gaining entry to properties via insecure windows. We understand that at the minute this beautiful weather, but we must reiterate when you leave your property or go upstairs make sure your property is secure, so offenders can't get it to your property and get your valuables.
