City of Wolverhampton Councils Environmental Crime Team deal with a wide range of issues including complaints regarding accumulations, waste and fly tipping. In this edition we are focusing on Household Waste and Recycling.

Unfortunately, we are still seeing fly tipping across the estate, the TMO and Wolverhampton City Council work hard to remove fly tipping. We are asking for your help to identify those responsible and help us to reduce this unsightly and selfish crime.

It is everyone's responsibility to dispose of their waste correctly, if you have any information that can assist us in tackling those responsible for fly tipping on the estate please contact the council on 01902 551155.

We know most of our residents dispose of their waste correctly and in a responsible way, but the actions of a few selfish individuals can blight the area. We want

residents to be proud of their estate and be able to enjoy the outdoor spaces. If we all continue to recycle correctly and dispose of household waste in the correct bins, any excess waste is kept to a minimum.

Guidance on how to avoid catching or spreading coronavirus (COVID-19)

DON'T:


X Do not touch your eyes, nose or mouth if your hands are not clean.
